SPEED

It is the goal of our community to make Rhododendron Park a better, safer place to live. We can start by getting to know our neighbors and create call circles. Also speak with our children about respect for others and others properties. There have been several reports of children jumping fences and not yielding to vehicles on the road. The safety & security of our children is #1. Please obey the posted 25 MPH speed limit through our community.

There have been numerous complaints and observations in regards to the following by-laws not being fol-

- Temporary Residence—No motor home, vehicle, trailer, tent, shack, garage or structure of a temporary character shall be used at any time as a residence, sleeping quarters or living space
- Garbage—No garbage or other waste shall be kept on any lot, except in sanitary containers
- Vehicle Storage—Each lot owner shall be responsible for the storage of inoperable & unlicensed vehicles and/or motor vehicle parts, tires, and other debris associated with motor vehicles, out of view of neighboring lots and the street while awaiting repair or removal,

The by-laws are in place to make our community a pleasant place to live & help keep our property values up. If the by-laws are not followed, fines & property liens will be assessed to those homeowners. Please see our website for all by-laws and exceptions.
