## Dear Postal Customer,

The U.S. Postal Inspection Service has learned that several mail boxes in your area were broken into and mail may have been stolen. If you were expecting checks or credit cards in the mail and did not receive them, report this under Consumer Awareness via <a href="https://postalinspectors.uspis.gov">https://postalinspectors.uspis.gov</a>. [You may also complete a copy of PS Form 2016 (included with this letter) at your local post office to submit to the USPIS.] The information you provide to Postal Inspectors, increases the likelihood of catching the perpetrator.

Follow these guidelines to protect yourself from mail theft:

- Deposit outgoing mail in a blue collection box, at a Post Office, or by handing it directly to your letter carrier.
- Never leave mail in your mailbox overnight—that's when thieves often attack.
- If you see suspicious activity around your mailbox, call your local police and Postal Inspectors at 877-USMAIL5.

We regret any inconvenience this may have caused you, and thank you for any assistance you can provide.

If any of your accounts have been compromised or you have information as to who may have committed these thefts, please report this to your bank and notify the United States Postal Inspection Service at 1-877-876-2455, select option 5.
